- Men's team (one team from each Association)
- Women's team (one team from each Association)
- Men's single (up to 8 players from each Association)
- Women's single (up to 8 players from each Association)
- Men's doubles (up to 4 pairs from each Association)
- Women's doubles (up to 4 pairs from each Association)
- Mixed doubles (up to 8 pairs from each Association)

**6. PARTICIPATION**

Invitations are addressed to all member Associations of North European Table Tennis Union: Denmark, Estonia, Faroe Islands, Finland, Greenland, Iceland, Latvia, Lithuania, Norway and Sweden.  
 One umpire from each Association is welcome with free hospitality from Thursday to Sunday.

**7. SYSTEM OF PLAY****NETU Championships team events:**

- Events with 5 teams, one group playing for positions 1 – 5.
- Events with 6 - 8 teams, playing in 2 groups, the 2 best teams in each group playing semifinals/finals. Team number 3 and 4, will play for positions 5 and lower.
- Events with more than 8 teams: the teams will play in 3 groups. Then it will be 6 teams playing quarterfinals/semifinals/finals. Teams finishing 3 and 4 in the groups play for positions 7 and lower.
- Men's and women's team – best of 5 singles (a team shall consist of 3 players);
- Each team match best of 5 games (same system of play as the World Team Championships);

**NETU Championships single events:**

- The 8 highest ranked players join the other players in second stage.
- The other players play in first stage in groups of 3 or 4; all matches will be best of 5 games;
- First priority should be 3 players in the group. The 2 best players in each group qualify for second stage.
- The second stage is a knock-out competition; all matches will be best of 7 games;

**NETU Doubles and Mixed doubles events:**

- Doubles will be best of 5 games.
